Project architect selected

In fall 2018, UCSF selected The Boldt Company as the design builder and lead of the design-build team for the UCSF Research and Academic Building at ZSFG. In partnership with UCSF and with participation from representatives of the UCSF at ZSFG community, Boldt has selected Skidmore, Owings & Merrill LLP (SOM) as the project architect.

Designing the building


With an architecture firm in place as part of the project team, the design phase for the new building will begin. This process will include participation from Design Groups for different categories of space type, including wet labs, dry labs and administrative areas, shared research cores, facilities for patient-centered research, and education space. In these Design Groups future users of the building will have the opportunity to review proposed designs and provide detailed review and comment to the architect based on Design Criteria that have been developed for the facility. The Design Groups recommendations will also be shared with the ZSFG Vice Dean.

Education Cores Patient Research Dry Lab & Office The group members will consider ideas at a more detailed level than the initial focus group meetings held during the programming phase in 2016. We expect each group will hold 4-6 meetings of 1-2 hours in length at ZSFG over the next 6 - 8 months. Participants will be expected to attend all their group meetings in addition to researching and reviewing materials.
