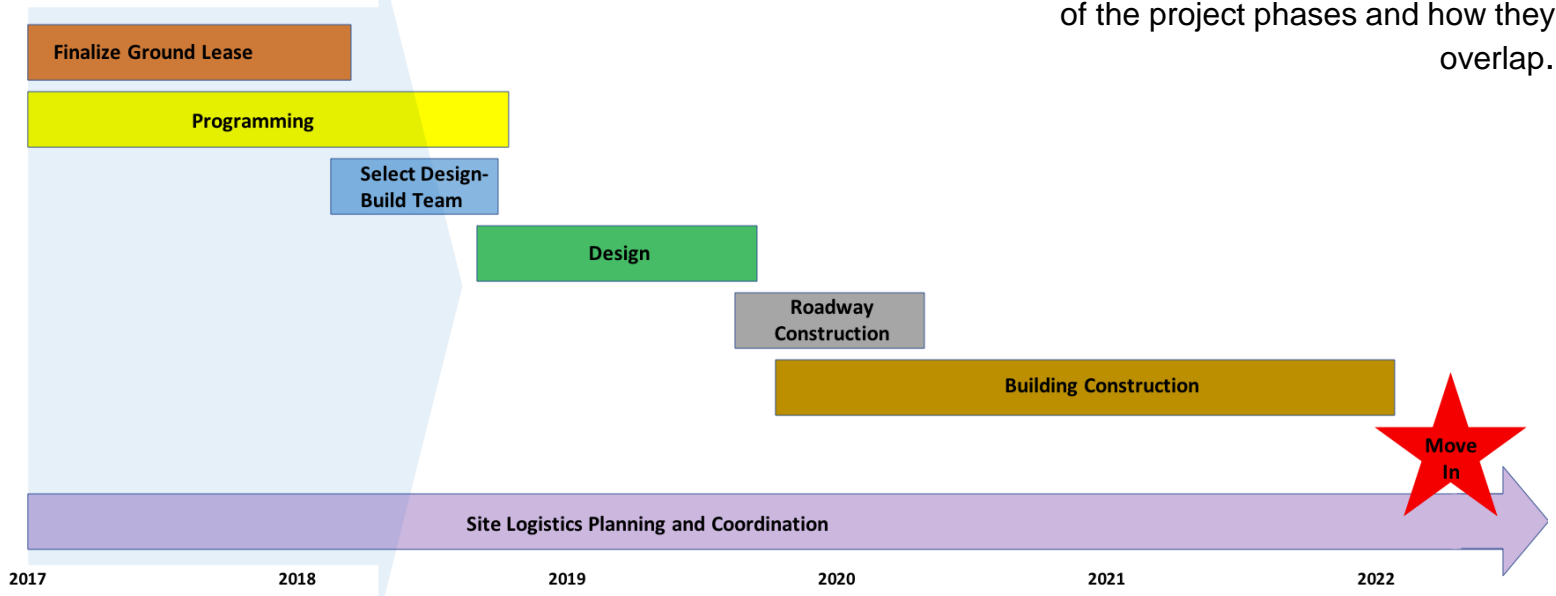
Selection of design and construction team: builder selected

Following a public process to select the main members of the integrated project team, The Boldt Company has been selected as the general contractor for the UCSF Research and Academic Building at ZSFG. Boldt's project team is scheduled to start setting up offices in the project's Big Room (project offices), located on 16th Street, in early October.

The next step in establishing the design-build team will be choosing the architecture firm for the project. This selection will be made in cooperation with Boldt and is expected to be completed by mid-October. In addition to the architect, the process for selection of a structural engineering firm is also underway.

Project schedule

Designing the building

Once the project architect has been chosen the design phase will begin. The project team will establish a design process that includes working with the Design Groups, providing opportunity for future users of the building to contribute, and sharing regular updates. The Design Groups will meet with the project team to provide information on how they envision working in the new building and input on design.
