



Clinical Sciences Building Retrofit and Renovation

The Clinical Sciences Building (CSB) is being renovated to meet current seismic safety requirements and to provide instructional and meeting spaces that support modern teaching and research. The project will also connect Parnassus Ave. to the interior Saunders Court with a new entrance and gateway. Construction is scheduled to be complete in late 2019.

February 2019

Noisy work

- Noisy demolition in Magnolia Court (adjacent to the pedestrian spine) is scheduled intermittently through February as work continues to remove the walkway and connections between UC Hall and CSB.
- Demolition of a concrete wall inside the lower level of CSB near MSB is scheduled starting Feb. 8 and expected to continue through the following week.

Construction Activity

- Shear wall construction continues throughout the building.
- Concrete pours are taking place throughout the project, including for the elevator pit at basement level and foundation footings for the new pavilion.
- Foundation footings work for pavilion includes excavation, rebar, and concrete pours. Waterproofing continues.
- Steel fabrication for the pavilion structure started this month at an off-site location. Installation is scheduled to begin in mid-March.

Infrequent, short (2-5 minute) closures of the pedestrian spine between Nursing and UC Hall are expected; flaggers will be present to provide direction.
