

Recent Activity:

- Site grading for the building pad now shows an outline of the RAB's future footprint.
- Underground utility work began in the 23rd Street sidewalk near Vermont on October 13th; pedestrian detours are in place weekdays 7am - 3:30pm for approximately two weeks.

Anticipated Activity in the Near Future:

- Activity will continue on the roadway with foundation work, rebar installation and wood framing for a ramp at the northeast part of the project site.
- Drilling of building foundation footings is scheduled to begin in November and continue for four weeks. Noise from the pneumatic drill may be louder when the drill has to get through rock or harder soil.
